The money she has raised will be used for the construction of a deep bore-hole and water pump, adjacent to the health clinic.



To put it into her words:

Community Support

Sanitation

To date, we have built a total of six EcoDome solar-powered, waterless toilets around Njebwa village and Mkama School. We intend to build more as and when funds become available.

Water

To-date we have installed three water bore holes and pumps to provide safe clean water for the community. The intention is to install another one at the health clinic

and as funds become available we hope to provide further units in surrounding villages.

Embangweni Hospital

We have already supplied the hospital with 100 bed sheets for the inpatients. We are in the process of procuring 100 mosquito nets for the hospital which includes a children's wing and maternity unit.

We are hoping to supply blankets for hospital use as and when we have funds.

Education

Education is the original project for which UOP was founded. We pay school fees and other related school costs for secondary school, college and university students.

As primary school education is free in Malawi, many children are unable to progress beyond that point due to lack of fees.

Therefore, UOP's involvement at this stage is crucial for their educational advancement.

Currently, we support 30 children at secondary school, one at the University of Mzuzu, Malawi and one at Malamulo Medical College. To-date, we have sponsored over 100 students through various stages of further education.

Education is an ongoing project for UOP.

Mkama Primary School

This is the school serving Njebwa Village and surrounding area which we have supported by providing:

- Construction of school blocks and teachers' houses
- Desks and other school equipment
- School uniforms
- Sports kits for football and netball
- Water bore hole and pump

- Solar-powered, waterless toilets
- First Aid equipment
- Solar lamps

Due to our efforts, Mkama Primary School is now a much sought-after educational establishment and is being used by the Ministry of Education as an examination centre.



Health Clinic

UOP's 2015 project was the successful completion of a five-room health clinic which is now serving the communities of Njebwa and the surrounding villages.

The clinic is being used as an outreach health centre by the nearest local hospital, Embangweni Hospital.

Services at the health clinic currently include:

- Health assessments and weight checks for children under 5 years old
- Maternity clinic
- AIDS/HIV testing and counselling
- Malaria testing
- Family planning.




In order to further support the clinic, we will be fundraising for furnishings and equipment, including benches, desks, chairs and bedding.

Future projects

Once we have raised sufficient funds, we intend to provide the following – although not necessarily in the order listed.

- Build a house for staff at the health clinic
- Provide more water bore-holes and pumps
- Build an additional school block at Mkama with library and solar-powered lighting

- Provide further school uniforms
- Construct additional teachers' houses
- Provide further EcoDome solar-powered, waterless toilets
- Build a Skills Centre
- Provide further supplies and support to Embangweni Hospital.


